TASK 1: Please complete **ONE** of the following two assignments:

A)

“The internet has become an invaluable tool for organisations including schools and local government offices, but breaches in internet security can have a damaging effect on its usefulness.”

Write an essay of not more than 2500 words which:

Discusses the above statement and outlines how you or your organisation have protected itself from the potential damage caused by internet security breaches and the impact such measures have on your role within the organisation.

B)

“The organisational changes taking place within certain commercial practices as a result of the increasing use of teleworking have far reaching implications.”

Write an essay of not more than 2500 words which:

Discusses both the national and international implications of such changes and comments on the appropriateness of teleworking within your own organisation.

The essay must include a list of all the references which can be web sites, books, magazines and journals. These references must be cited correctly as follows:

- internet sites: must include their URL together with the date visited;
- journals: article title, author(s), journal, volume, pages, date;
- text books: the name, title, publisher, date published and ISBN;
- magazines: article title, authors, magazine, pages, date.
